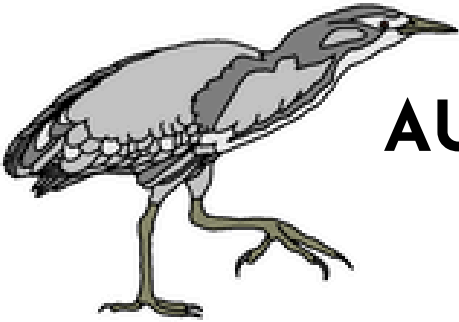

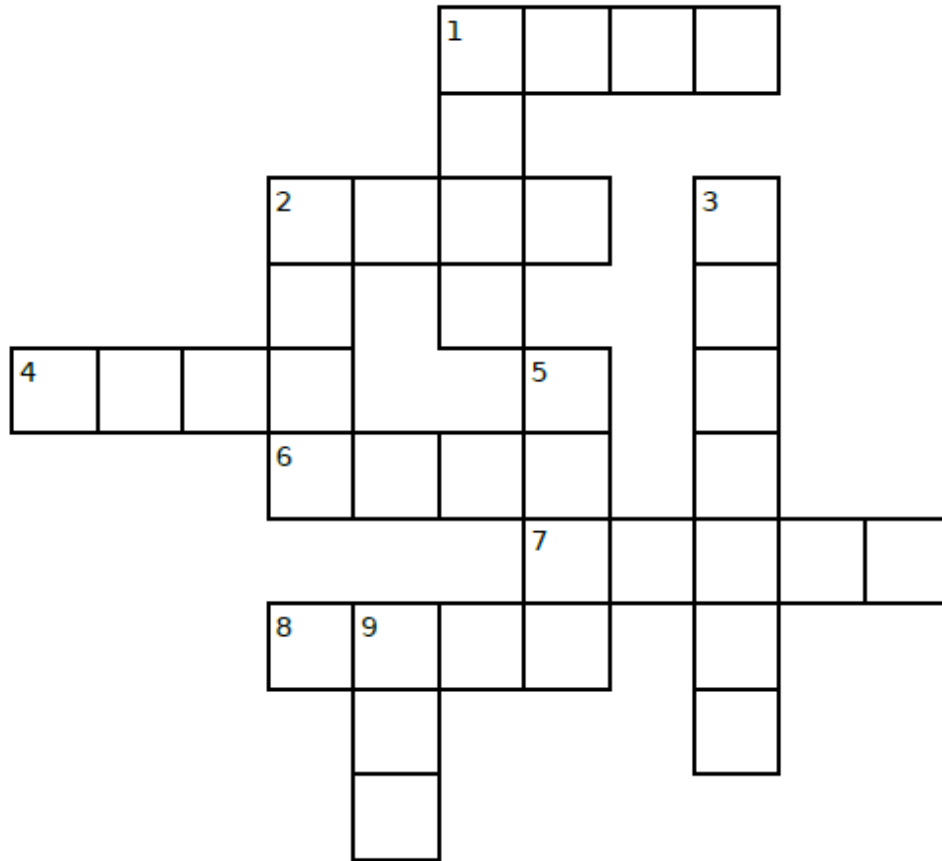

AUSTRALASIAN BITTERN CRISS-CROSS



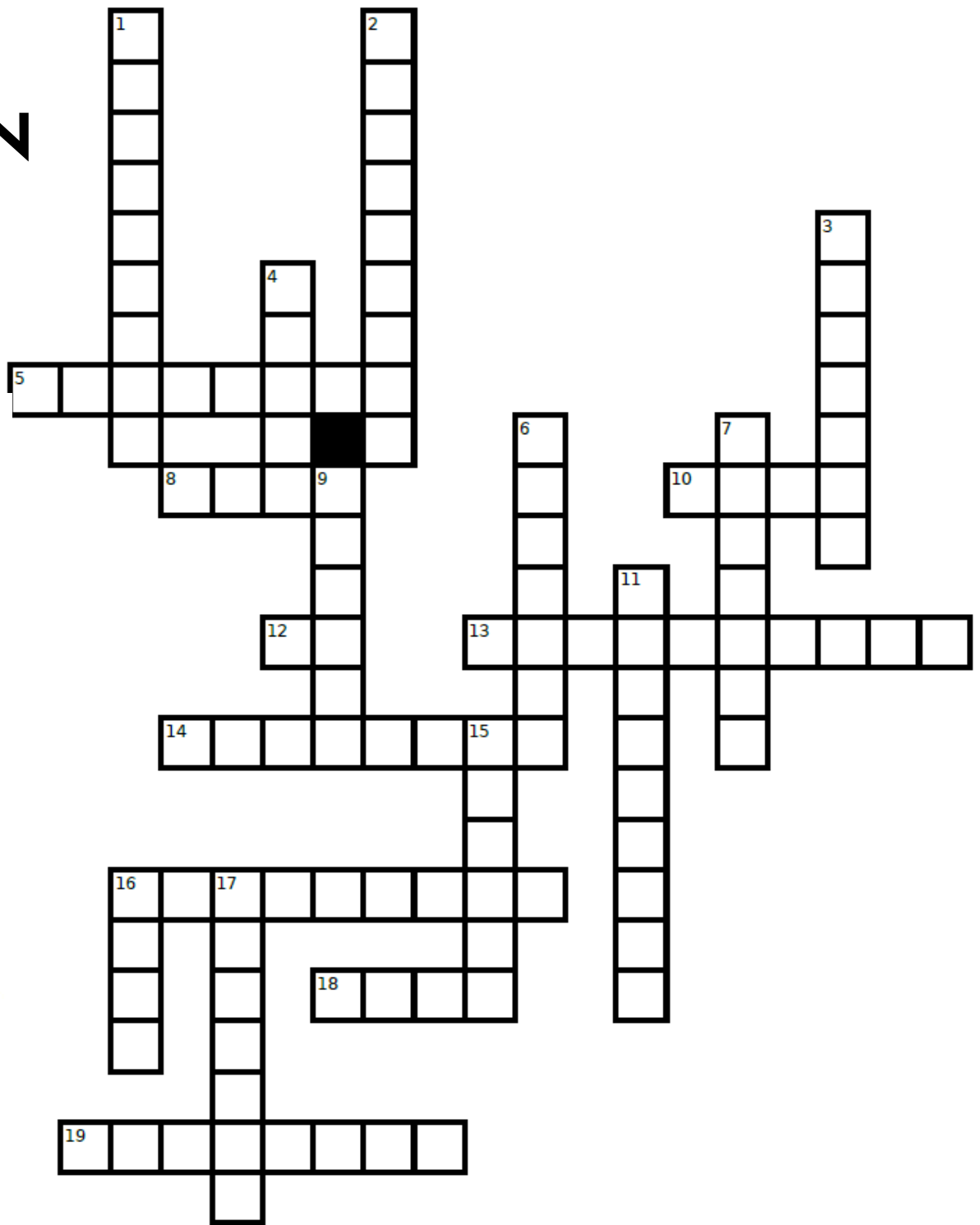
